

COVID-19 Pandemic

Drove unprecedented disruption locally and across the globe



Operational Impact

- Mandatory shutdowns
- Social distancing rules
- GRRL Library closed / reopened with limited services in [month]
- Friends Bookstore closed (March – December 2020)
- No Bag Sale, Newsletters, or Volunteer Appreciation Brunch

Financial Impact



• Total Revenue down 71%: \$16,992 vs. \$57,813 in 2019



• Bookstore Revenue down **75%:** \$10,567 vs. \$43,698 in 2019



• Memberships down 14%: \$4,405



How SCFOL Funds were used in 2020



Staff Report: GRRL update for 2020

- March 16: Library closed due to the pandemic
- Services Pivoted: Increased digital collection and eCard account access; added a region-wide hot line and on-line chat
- Mid-May: Started offering curbside services
- August: St. Cloud location was one of the first metro libraries in MN to offer 'Grab and Go' services
